From the rough-edged courts of Astoria, Queens, Chamique Holdsclaw became a 3-time NCAA champ and the No. 1 draft pick in the WNBA, impressing crowds with her artistry, athleticism, and drive. Hailed as the "female Michael Jordan.," Holdsclaw seemed destined for a spectacular professional career—until a long-suppressed battle with mental illness threatened to derail her life.

Mind Game: The Unquiet Journey of Chamique Holdsclaw chronicles both Holdsclaw's athletic accomplishments and personal setbacks, including her decision, despite public stigma, to become an outspoken mental health advocate. Still, she would face dramatic, unexpected challenges to her own recovery in this powerful story of courage, struggle, and redemption.
