SOM OP: 50.01, Annual Departmental Program Report

PURPOSE: The purpose of this School of Medicine (SOM) policy and procedure is to

establish a policy regarding annual departmental program reports to the

Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC).

REVIEW: This SOM Policy and Procedure shall be reviewed within each odd-

numbered fiscal year by the TTUHSC Graduate Medical Education

Coordinating Council. Revisions will be forwarded to the Office of the Dean

for approval and publication

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

- 1. **Evaluation of Curriculum.** Program must submit a formal, systemic evaluation of the curriculum at least annually to the GMEC no later than June 30th of each year via the Designated Institutional Official in the GME Office. The report should include, but is not limited to the following:
 - a. Resident performance
 - b. Faculty development
 - c. Graduate performance, including performance of program graduates on the certification examination; and,
 - d. Program quality, specifically:
 - 1) Resident and faculty must have the opportunity to evaluate the program confidentially and in writing at least annually; and,
 - 2) The program must use the results of the residents' assessments of the program together with other evaluation results to improve the program.

(Note: This is an ACGME common program requirement that is part of every Residency Review Committee site visit.)

Plan of Action. If deficiencies are found, the program should also prepare a written plan of action to document initiatives to improve performance in the areas listed above. The action plan should be submitted to the GMEC for review and recommendation.
