PURPOSE: The purpose of this School of Medicine (SOM) policy and procedure is

to establish a policy for issuing Certificates of Completion for Residency/

Fellowship training.

REVIEW: This SOM Policy and Procedure shall be reviewed within each odd-

numbered fiscal year by the TTUHSC Graduate Medical Education

Coordinating Council. Revisions will be forwarded to the Office of the Dean

for approval and publication

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

1. Issuance of Certificates.

- a. Certificates will be issued to residents successfully completing their preliminary post-graduate year.
- b. Certificates of Completion will be issued to residents satisfactorily completing residency training requirements for board eligibility.
- c. Certificates of Completion will be issued to fellows satisfactorily completing fellowship training requirements for board eligibility.
- d. Certificates may be issued to residents who complete an intern year of training at the recommendation of the program directors.
- **2. Non-completion of Training.** A letter containing dates of attendance will be provided for those who do not complete their training.
