### ➤ Services Provided

- 24-hour Crisis Hotline
- Counseling Services
- SANE Examinations
- Case Referral and Follow-up
- “Close To Home” Education Programs:
  - First Time Offender Prevention-Middle and High Schools
  - Rural Outreach

### ➤ Clients’ Health Needs

- Psychiatric counseling and support
- Safe Places
- Nutritional Needs
- Rehabilitation for self/forced medicating
- Screening for STI/STD

### ➤ Clients’ Health Information Needs

- Medical/Judicial/Law Enforcement Accompaniment
- Most at risk populations 12-14yo girls
- 85% of victims know their perpetrator

### ➤ Advice for Physicians

- Expand your knowledge on the issues affecting **YOUR** community such as rates of domestic violence, sexual assault, etc., and educate yourselves on how these issues will appear
- Listen and delve deeper if you believe something is happening during your patient encounter; ask more questions and hopefully open a door to get useful and actionable information
