Clients' Health Needs

- Access to resources for learning disabilities: dyslexia, low IQ
- Better assessment following health incidents such as stroke

Clients' Health Information Needs

- Patient literacy – reading prescription or nutrition labels
- Communicating with health professionals

Advice for Physicians

- Do not judge
- Understand that low literacy can affect patient adherence and outcomes
- Help provide resources to children and adults who do not have the means otherwise
- Provide tips and tricks that can help patients manage in the meantime, such as matching labels
