

SCHOOL OF PHARMACY PHARM.D/ MBA SELECTION COMMITTEE

Each applicant for the PharmD-MBA program must complete the requirements for the School of Pharmacy, the College of Business as well as the Graduate School. Each program controls their admissions policies, admission procedures, and enrollment. Each applicant must meet the requirements of the School of Pharmacy to be considered a potential applicant for the Pharm.D/ MBA program.

Students who have not begun their academic work in the School of Pharmacy (identified as P0 students) and students who are rising P2 will be advised by the Program Director by email to begin the process of completing the composite School of Business/Graduate School application form after a School of Pharmacy Selection Committee has met and voted to advance the application of candidates for the program. If the the Selection Committee does not recommend an applicant to the Dean of the School of Pharmacy and Rawls College of Business, the Program Director will inform the candidate by email.

The Selection Committee consists of faculty, and staff members in Student Affairs. Any information available to the Committee can be considered. The Committee will be interested in previous academic results, especially in any business or social sciences courses; GMAT or PCAT scores, if taken, and most importantly, documentation of a BS, BA or BBA degree. Candidates will NOT be favorably reviewed if they do not possess a bachelors degree by the end of the spring semester before commencing MBA classes. No exceptions will be made.

Accepted students into the PharmD-MBA program who do not have scores for the GMAT or PCAT will be required to apply for a waiver. Students will be provided with the contact email to request the waiver at the time of acceptance.

Letters of recommendation will be required to complete the School of Business/Graduate School application. The same letters written to apply to the School of Pharmacy can be used.
