(Stating the sentiments of the Student Senate congratulating Dr. John Norbury for establishing the new Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Residency (PM&R) at TTUHSC.)

WHEREAS, Dr. Norbury served as an assistant professor at East Carolina University for 10 years prior to joining TTUHSC; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Norbury joined TTUHSC as the Division Chief and Residency Program Director in July 2021; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Norbury serves as a board member of the American Association of Neuromuscular & Electrodiagnostic Medicine (AANEM) and has written over 14 publications and 49 peer reviewed abstracts during his career; and,
